BASICS update

There has been some very exciting progress over the past year with the purchase of a suitable block of land where a new centre will be built. Old buildings have been demolished, the land cleared and plans drawn up for a larger modern more suitable purpose built centre

Part of this work will be done with hands-on assistance from a number of Australian companies who have businesses and offices in Ghana.

The new centre will give autonomy to the 'BASICS' Safe Haven Centre and allow it to move forward with greater confidence while providing for an increased number of children and the many activities the children enjoy.

Your ongoing support will ensure this important project reaches fruition as quickly as possible. Substantial sums of money will be needed to build the centre and with the world wide financial crisis there have been flow on effects for the staff and students at the BASICS Safe Haven Centre.

Many of the long term American supporters have changed the level and focus of their annual pledges and although this will be a temporary situation it has placed extraordinary pressure on the 16 staff members who work tirelessly to maintain the many valuable services they provide the children.

With running costs of \$180K to \$200K a year it is imperative BASICS Australian supporters continue to commit financial support to the centre.

Daniel Sackey Talks about his visit to BASICS in Accra Ghana

In August this year I visited BASICS in Accra Ghana to see the outstanding work that Pat Wilkins the BASICS Founder is doing with disadvantaged kids.

I surprised Pat and the kids as I wanted to see what they do on a day to day basis. I lived in Accra for most of my life however it was a challenge to find the house because it was in a suburb I did not know.

Pat and Allotey made me very welcome and introduced me to the children and volunteers. The children range in age from 6 years to fifteen years and mix and work well as a group. Lunch had just finished and one group were cleaning the dishes while others were playing scrabble. The third group were stretching in preparation for a basketball game.

I spoke to the group encouraging them to seize this opportunity to turn their lives around with the resources available to them and later in life they will be able to help others who face similar challenges.

The smiles on the children's faces showed how much they appreciated this calm haven and for the staff the rewards are seeing the children happy and the many positive changes in them. In most cases these young people have wandered in from the streets and local beaches looking for security and opportunities. Their lives are changed by the many programs offered and the support and encouragement they receive.

I have experienced firsthand the ongoing challenges BASICS faces and would like to take this opportunity to encourage you to continue to donate and support this amazing place. You will be giving many very disadvantaged children the chance of a better life.
